RESTAURANTS

Andrew Edmunds

46 Lexington Street, London, W1F OLP

Andrew Edmunds is a Soho gem and the ultimate celebrity dog hang out, offering an ever-changing menu of seasonal British dishes. 10 minutes' walk from Rosewood London.

Fallow

2 St. James's Market, London, SW1Y 4RP

Fallow in Mayfair is a restaurant elevating humble produce to exciting new heights with creativity and sustainability at the forefront of their menu. 25 minutes' walk from Rosewood London.

Café ZL

20 Sherwood St, London, W1F 7ED Sip a coffee or a glass of wine with light petits plats and pretend that you're in France in this off-street Parisian-style café in the middle of Soho. Only small dogs are allowed at the manager's discretion, so give your dog a beret and sweet-talk your way in. 20 minutes' walk from Rosewood London.

Riding House Café

43-51 Great Titchfield Street, London, W1W 7PQ Located just off Oxford Street, the comfort food and all-day brasserie classics in quirky, retroinspired surroundings, where dogs are welcome. 25 minutes' walk from Rosewood London.

Colbert

50-52 Sloane Square, Chelsea, London, SW1W 8AX

Sloane Square's stylish Colbert gives dogs a real VIP experience, providing bones and bowls of water to keep your pooch pampered and for the duration of your visit. Take the Piccadilly line from Holborn to South Kensington and District Line to Sloane Square.

Maggie Jones

6 Old Court Place, Kensington Church Street, London, W8 4PL A favourite of Princess Anne, (she used to book their under the name 'Maggie Jones'), this eccentric restaurant which is tucked away in a little corner of Kensington, bursts with cosy clutter. The inviting menu features classic British dishes and the friendly staff are happy to accommodate well-behaved hounds. Take the Central line from Holborn Station to Notting Hill Gate.

CAFÉS & PUBS

7 The Crown & Two Chairmen

31-32 Dean Street, London, W1D 3SB This Soho stalwart is happy to welcome you and your dog for an authentic British pub experience – head there on a Sunday and tuck into one of their roasts. 10 minutes' walk from Rosewood London.

8 Redemption Roasters

40 Drury Lane, London, WC2B 5RR Offering speciality coffee from the perfect creamy flat white to sweet pour-over coffee and don't miss the doggie treats on the side in their very own jar. This light filled space is perfect for your morning brew and brunch before a wonder round the shops and culture in neighbouring Covent Garden. 7 minutes' walk from Rosewood London.

9 Punch Tavern

99 Fleet Street, London, EC4Y 1DE This Grade II listed Victorian former gin palace is brimming with history and also a big fan of dogs. Take a look at the original features like the fireplace, oak panelling and marble bar, as well as some original Punch & Judy painting while you're there. 15 minutes' walk from Rosewood London.

10 The Grazing Goat




11 The Thomas Cubitt

Dogs are welcome in the downstairs bar with its classic country-house style interior. Take the Central line from Holborn Station to Oxford Circus and then the Victoria line to Victoria station.

12 Noble Rot

51 Lamb's Conduit Street, London, WC1N 3NB The sophisticated wine bar and restaurant in Bloomsbury allows your four-legged friend into the bar section where you can enjoy deliciously undervalued wines by the glass or hard-to-find gems from the world's leading winemakers. 10 minutes' walk from Rosewood London.
