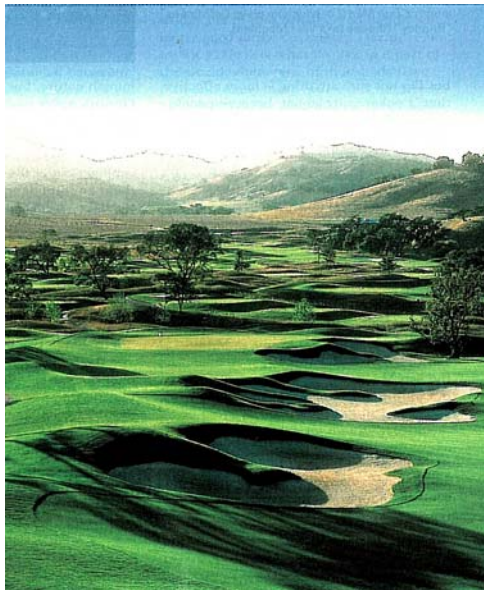

## CORDEVALLE

A bit of a surprise? Not to us, or to voters who recognize modern greatness when they see and play it. Robert Trent Jones II and his team of Palo Alto-based designers brought all their considerable talent to bear when they laid out this balanced and sometimes brutal beauty, centerpiece of a secluded-yet-accessible high-end resort folded into a lovely valley just south of San Jose. CordeValle — new home for the PGA Tour's Frys.com Open come October — is actually part of a private club established in the heady dotcom days, but guests staying in a stunning villa or bungalow can get a tee time, hire a caddy and get the full-on member treatment for as long as they're inside the gates. Old-growth trees, protected wetlands, grassy hillsides, bold bunkering, wicked and wonderful greens: This is big boy golf that's every bit the match of anything down on the Monterey Peninsula.
