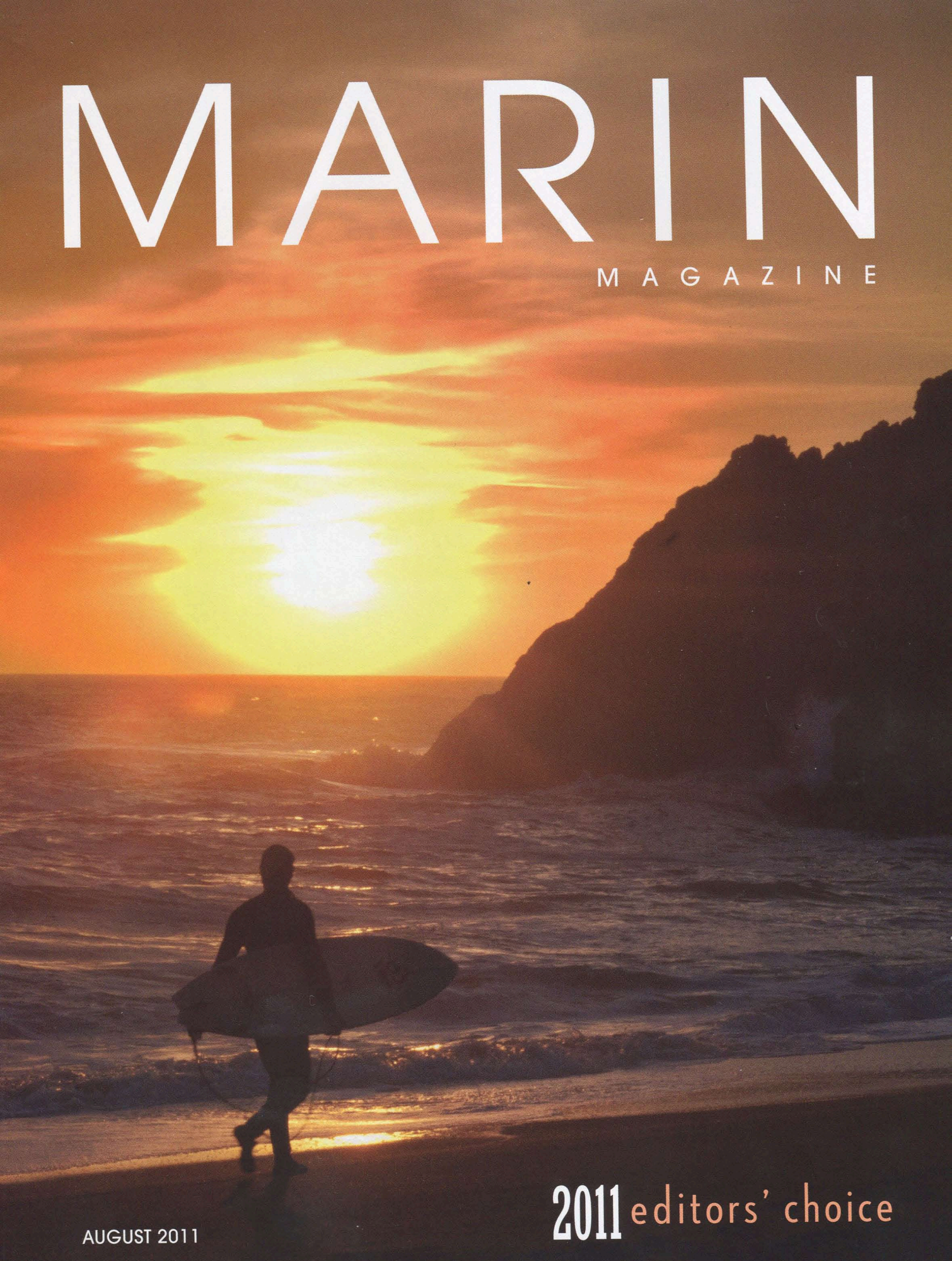

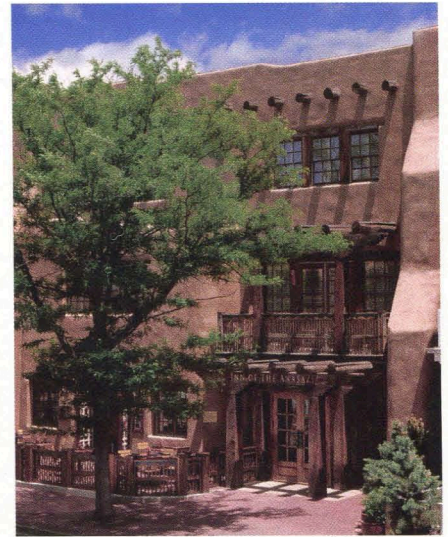
Dog Friendly
