Originally from Paris, Vincent graduated from Ecole Hoteliere de Lausanne before joining the Ritz-Carlton group in 2003. For the next 15 years he progressed within the group in a variety of posts in the USA and other destinations in Asia. In 2013 he became the Ritz-Carlton group's youngest General Manager, his first appointment at that level, and in 2016 he joined the Bulgari Shanghai Hotel & Residences as General Manager, with responsibility for the property's opening strategy, positioning and management, before becoming Hotel General Manager of the St. Regis Singapore in 2019.

Returning to Paris, Vincent joined Rosewood in early 2020 following his appointment as Managing Director of Hôtel de Crillon, A Rosewood Hotel, which, under his leadership, successfully continued the reopening journey, launched new F&B venues such as Nonos and Comestibles by Paul Pairet and Butterfly Pâtisserie, celebrated major Parisian milestones including the Olympic Games, and has been awarded several coveted accolades, including the renewed prestigious Palace distinction, Forbes Travel Guide 5 Star recognition, and a place on the inaugural World's 50 Best Hotels list in both 2023 and 2024.

Since 2024, he has been promoted to Regional Vice President to support Rosewood's growth in Europe and optimize its operational excellence with openings such as Rosewood Amsterdam and upcoming Rosewood Courchevel and continuing to lead, position and grow Hotel de Crillon to remain an iconic Parisian landmark, a former royal palace and monument to French culture where refined splendor and contemporary elegance intertwine.
