Walking back towards Russell Square, you reach 5 Woburn Walk, home to great Irish poet WB Yeats, before heading to neighbouring 51 Gordon Square, where Virginia Woolf lived with members of the Bloomsbury Group.

Walk down the western flank of Russell Square to Senate House, the inspiration for George Orwell's Ministry of Truth in his famous novel, 1984.

Circumnavigate the British Museum to one of London's oldest esoteric bookshops at 49 Museum Street. Then it's back to High Holborn and eastbound, home to a well-deserved drink in Scarfes bar.




