



## CODE OF CONDUCT

## PROTECTED NATURAL AREAS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL ZONES

- Respect visiting hours
- Travel on authorized roads and trails
- When you walk along a path, try to do it in silence to avoid noise
- Nuisance to other visitors and to the fauna of the environment.
- Avoid entering unauthorized areas
- Always park in authorized places
- Respect the signage, facilities and monuments
- Leave with the garbage generated during your visit
- Respect the instructions of the staff of the site visited
- Avoid extracting flora, fauna or any object in the area
- Do not feed the fauna of the place
- Don't throw eigarette butts or matches on the ground
- Avoid going up to ruins and monuments if it is forbidden
- Do not step on, scratch or mark any artistic work
- Do not take flash photography if it is prohibited
- Behave in full respect for the cultural identity of the communities.
- If you can, choose local products to enhance local economic development.
- Avoid using harmful chemicals (like sunscreens with Oxybenzone or Benzophenone 3, Octinoxate and Octocrylene or toxic bug repellants)
- Do not purchase items made with endangered flora or fauna.
- Choose wisely your meals, exotic dishes made with sensitive species might damage the biodiversity of the area.
