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WINE OF THE MONTH



ADELAIDE HILLS PENFOLDS BIN 23 PINOT NOIR

Bin 23 derives its name from ‘Cellar 23’ at Magill Estate, where Pinot Noir barriques are often stored during maturation. It follows in the footsteps of the Penfolds Cellar Reserve Pinot Noir, a wine first made from Adelaide Hills grapes in 1997.

Dark cherries, strawberry sorbet and barberries provide a delightful aromatic lift. Earthy forest floor and cold lamb capocollo adding the savory notes. A lovely texture on the palate, with fine, delicate tannins. Steely acidity drives the length providing succulent minerality.
