LOCATION: Cape Kidnappers is located at the southern end of Hawkes Bay, on the east

coast of New Zealand's North Island. It is approximately 30 minutes from

Napier and Hastings by car.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Cape Kidnappers Golf Course features 18 holes designed by world renowned

course architect Tom Doak. Opened in 2004, the layout immediately took its place among golf's modern architectural marvels, earning international acclaim for strategic qualities equal to its stunning views. The western shore of Cape Kidnappers itself features sheer cliffs that drop 150 meters into Hawkes Bay. Doak's routing plays right along the edge of these dramatic cliffs. And yet, the elegant inland holes play through a ridge-and-valley landscape of comparable beauty and strategic character. Cape Kidnappers Golf Course has consistently ranked among the world's top 50 golf courses. It played host to the PGA TOUR's Kiwi Challenge in 2008 and 2009. In 2022, Doak oversaw a renovation at included rebuilding and regrassing all 18 putting surfaces. Only the soil profiles beneath the green were affected; the original contours were all scrupulously restored. The project also included

the regrassing of all 18 fairways.

PRACTICE FACILITIES:

Cape Kidnappers offers a full practice facility complete with a driving range with target greens, a chipping green, and a putting green.

DRESS CODE:

MEN: shirts with collars and sleeves, slacks or Bermuda length shorts are required. Tank tops, tee shirts, cut-offs, sweatpants, warm-up suits, blue jeans or denim shorts, or athletic shorts are not permitted.

WOMEN: dresses, skirts, mid-length shorts, and shirts with either a collar or sleeves are considered appropriate attire. Halter tops, tee shirts, bathing suits, sweatpants, warm-up suits, blue jeans or denim shorts, or athletic shorts are not permitted.

SHOES: golf shoes must have plastic spikes. Metal spikes are not permitted on the golf course. Tennis, soft sole, and field shoes are only permitted if approved by the Golf Shop.

The dress code is mandatory for all players and anyone wishing to use the practice facility. Improperly dressed golfers will be asked to change before being allowed to play or practice.

**GETTING THERE:** 

**BY AEROPLANE:** Air New Zealand operates scheduled daily flights from Auckland (AKL) to Napier airport (NPE). Charter flights can also be organized.

**BY HELICOPTER:** several helicopter companies operate flights from Auckland, Napier, Wellington, and other New Zealand destinations to Cape Kidnappers. We will gladly assist in making these arrangements for you.

**BY CAR:** from Auckland, the trip is approximately 6 hours or 440 kms; from Wellington the trip is approximately 4 hours 45 minutes or 324 kms. We are located 30 minutes from the Napier airport, the Napier waterfront, and Hastings.
